Upon expiry of the Event Day Period and by no later than 15h00, the Artworks painted at the Designated Area by the Finalists will be judged by the Landlord with the assistance of selected independent judges representing the Landlord and Wonderboom Junction (Judges) to select the top 2 winning artworks (Winners).</p> <p>The Winners will be ranked first prize and second prize and also be presented with prizes for each team and their schools.</p> <p>The entire process will be overseen by an independent auditor.</p>
